Alone, just out of the egg, Baby Bird is lost in all senses of the word. She only knows one thing: she must find her mother.


While stumbling through the neighborhood, she encounters H_{en} , K_{itten} , and \mathcal{D}_{og} . All three realize that they, too, are lonely.


The animals find that they make more progress towards their goals when they join together. With determination—and the help of her friends—Baby Bird finally finds her mother.

Baby Bird has fallen out of the nest. Can you be Baby Bird's friend and help her find the way to Mother Bird?


